Position Summary

In this position you will provide key warehousing and equipment refurbishing functions. Additionally, you will provide key support to the installation and route technician teams. There will be daily interaction with company owner, management, route, service & install technicians, sales staff, warehouse manager & customers, and will report to the Warehouse & General Managers.

Key Responsibilities include:

Dishmachine Equipment Refurbishing

- Clean & refurbish commercial dishmachines, booster heaters, dishmachine tabling & other rental equipment to established standards
- Clean & refurbish dispensing equipment and package for reuse to established standards

Warehouse

- Pick, pack & prepare distributor orders for pickup by common carrier
- Receive & restock vendor deliveries
- Daily down-stocking of product & supplies
- Maintain general tidiness and cleanliness of warehouse & property grounds, inc. floor cleaning, trash pickup & removal, and routine equipment inspection
- Assist with coordinating maintenance of company vehicle fleet

Parts Department

- Assist with parts department organization and expansion
- Place vendor purchase orders and process RMA / Warranty returns

Install Team Support

- Help prepare and gather product, equipment, & support materials for future installations
- Maintain & update dishmachine equipment inventory tracking spreadsheet

Route Technician Team Support

- Provide support for service & route technicians, including both in warehouse and in the field
- Ongoing learning and training of commercial dishmachine & dispensing equipment
